The meeting started with a condolence prayer in respect of the demised member Prof.Saurabh Ghosh. Then President ISMS, Prof. Jeyaseelan welcomed GC members, Committee chairs and past presidents who were present at the venue and requested General Secretary of the society to take up agenda items one by one.

Members after some discussion and clarifications, unanimously approved minutes of the 2021 GC and GB reports. Followed by, General Secretary presented report of the Society activities held during 2021-'22. The following is the summary of General Secretary's report and GC suggestions.

Secretariate regularly communicated various news items like Minutes of the meeting, Election results, ISMS bulletin, notifications of conferences and workshops, vacancies etc. which were relevant for the members, and other similar items to society members through google group. General secretary informed that the Awards, Certificates and Mementos of 2019 and 2020 awardees which were supposed to be awarded during 2020 and 2021 annual conferences respectively have been prepared and couriered to the recipients with a covering letter. All recipients have been acknowledged the receipt of it.

Thirty four, 34, new life members have been enrolled during 2022 and been provisionally admitted and GS sought GC's approval for their formal admission. The present GC has approved these admissions. Secretariat has updated membership list and all attempts have been made to update e-mail IDs in google group. At present we have nearly 800 e-mail IDs in google group and nearly one thousand life members of the society. Secretariat closely worked with Web coordinator, formed a sub-committee of members to update the ISMS website. The committee had many meetings during the year, sent many requests to members regarding additional materials and they are on the job of modernizing the website.

Secretariat closely worked with conference secretariat of ISMSCON-2022 in organizing the annual conference in terms of finalising scientific programmes, Inaugural function and other meetings during the conference.

Secretariat further supported the formation of election committee, communicating to the members of the committee and conduct of president elect and GC members elections. Prof.S.N Dwivedi has been elected as President elect., and Dr.K.T. Harichandrakumar, Dr.S.B.Tripathi and Prof. Saurabh Ghosh have been elected to the Governing Council. Prof. Ajit Sahai expressed his decision to resign from the nomination committee Chairmanship. The President in consultation with senior members of the society appointed Prof.P.Venkatesan as the Nomination committee Interim Chair. Further, General secretary reported that Prof.K.K Jose of School of Mathematical Sciences, MG University, Kottayam, Kerala has agreed to organise the 2023 annual National conference. General Secretary's report concluded with a thanking message to President, Treasurer, all past presidents and GC members whom he worked with during his tenure as General secretary for supporting the smooth functioning of his two tenures as General Secretary which is going to end in December 2022. Council approved the General Secretary's report.

Treasurer presented report of financial matters. The treasurer explained the financial positions which is relatively comfortable and presented the audited report for the FY 2021-'22, which will be circulated to all members later through google group and will be uploaded in the ISMS official website.

The Bulletin Editor Prof.K.Thennarasu presented the editorial activities carried out during the year. He mentioned about the publication of various issues of the bulletin and difficulty in getting articles from members. However within this constraint he was able to publish several issues. GC suggested to explore the feasibility of uploading videos of various training sessions in the ISMS website. Editor thanked all members for their support during his 5 years tenure as Editor which is ending in December 2022.

The Web coordinator could not attend the meeting due to personal reasons. However, he sent the report to the General Secretary and General Secretary presented the report in the Governing council meeting. In nutshell the following is the report.

The website hosting and its domain name are registered through the professional agency **'Orbit Info Solutions'**. Secretariat communications are uploaded regularly in the website. Two activities initiated that helped to restructure the website are;

I. Domain and hosting renewal

It was noted that the payment for website domain renewal / hosting were missed for the period 2016 onwards. Renewal payments were made based on consolidated invoice received from the provider, and domains/hosting support issues were resolved with support from Dr Jeyaseelan, Dr Sreekumaran Nair & Dr Binukumar. The website domain is reinstated and activated, and was communicated to the service provider to give timely intimations & invoices.

II . Website Content updation

It was recommended to update the website content reflect to current details related to a) Membership, b) Fellowship & Award rules, c) and other contents/ events that improve its usability. Toward this end, a committee to discuss content areas for addition in the website and their implementation was formed with the help of Dr. Sreekumaran Nair. The team had periodic meeting on Zoom to discuss areas of updating and its plan for implementation.

Members reported on the progress of undertaken tasks.

- A google survey form was designed and sent to members. Responses were tabulated on the google sheet. As of October 2022, the member updation survey resulted in ~ 70 responses (As of October, 2022).
- All proposed changes in design of website- such as revision of menu options, removal of duplication of documents, transfer of content in PDF to HTML and other related cosmetic changes were implemented.
- A request was sent to all office bearers to relay key messages that can be displayed in the home page of the website.

III . Summary & Next steps

Website updating activities were run smoothly through out the year. In the coming year, team will explore additional ways to reach-out to non-responders from email survey and finalize the updated list. The homepage with inclusion of key messages and visual aids will be redesigned. And methods to collate educational learning resources, events such as workshop and career notifications for display in the website are planned to be explored.

Chairs of Various committees presented their recommendations on awards and Nominations.

President as the Chair of FSMS committee, presented this year FSMS award recommendation for Dr.M.Vishnu Vardhana Rao, Director, ICMR-National Institute of Medical Statistics, New Delhi. GC approved it.

The GC recommended Prof.P.Venkatesan as a member in the FSMS committee in place of Prof.K.R.Sundaram.
